(DROP OFF ONLY NO CITY PICK UP)

Items Accepted

- Tires:
Up to 24.5" diameter vehicle tires, with or without rims.
(Limit 4 – additional \$2.00 per tire)
- Appliances:
Refrigerators (door removed), freezers (door removed), stoves, hot-water
Heaters, air conditioners, dehumidifiers,
microwave ovens, fluorescent
Light fixtures/no ballast (no bulbs)
- Automobile Batteries, Lawnmowers
- Televisions and other Video Display Devices (\$4.00 per item) VCR-Free
- Mattresses or Box Springs, Chairs, Sofas (\$10.00 per item)
- Demolition Wastes:
 - Bricks, wood, pallets, shingles, rolled roofing, lumber, electric wire, Sheetrock, Styrofoam insulation, Storm Windows
- Residential Trash:
Non-hazardous trash items only!
****Yard waste will be accepted at its compost site located just West of the cemetery, off Cemetery Road (no bags, please)****

Registration:

Drop off for Chisholm residents only. **You must pay in advance at City Hall for items that require a charge (See Above). Receipt will be required at drop off. No late registrations will be accepted.**

City Hall hours are 7:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Mon-Fri.

Preparation:

As stated above, doors must be removed from refrigerators and freezers. Other containers are not necessary.

Drop Off Schedule:

Drop off will be conducted from **July 16th thru July 20th**

TIMES: 7:00 a.m. – 3:30 p.m. – Monday, July 16th * Wednesday, July 18th* Friday, July 20th

7:00 a.m. – 7p.m. – Tuesday, July 17th and Thursday, July 19th
(Please note that containers are always available during the year for drop offs M-F, during working hours, at the City Garage. You must pay at City Hall for any items that have a fee and present receipt to City garage employee before dumping)
Alternative Fee Drop-off Sites:

The St. Louis County Solid Waste Department accepts tires (limit 4), appliances (limit 2), yard waste, batteries, used motor oil, scrap metal, used antifreeze, 4-foot fluorescent bulbs (limit 4) and oil filters (limit 4), free of charge at its Transfer Station in Hibbing and its Regional Landfill in Gilbert. Household hazardous wastes are collected by appointment on scheduled dates at no charge. Corrugated cardboard is accepted at Balkan Township Garage free of charge.
